2017 Supplemental Capital Budget, 2017-19 Reappropriations and Appropriation for the School Construction Assistance Program

Pending the enactment of the 2017-19 omnibus capital budget appropriations act, PSSB 5965 does the following:

- Provides \$335 million from the Common School Construction Account for school construction assistance in fiscal year 2018 in the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- Makes changes to the 2015-17 budget; the 2017 supplemental has a net savings of \$5.8 million.
- Makes reappropriations of \$2.5 billion for 2017-19 to ensure that projects authorized in prior biennia appropriations are able to continue without disruptions to construction schedules. This includes:
 - \$1.2 billion for natural resources projects;
 - \$584 million for public schools and other education;
 - \$447 million for general government projects;
 - \$167 million for higher education projects; and
 - \$116 million for human services projects.
