February 23, 2026 Version (H-3630.2) Compared to February 26, 2026 Version (H-3630.3)

Agency/Section	Description
<b>Commerce – Section 1007</b> 2025-27 Behavioral Health Facilities	1) Reduces the regional needs and closure prevention appropriation by \$7,505,000 in bonds. 2) Adds bond funding for the following projects: (a) \$6,700,000 for the Comprehensive Health Facility Acquisition project; and (b) \$1,550,000 for the Yakima Behavioral Health Hub project.  Total change in funding: Bonds: \$745,000
<b>Commerce – Section 1011</b> Housing Trust Fund	Adds the Office of Financial Management to the recipients of the report required of Commerce for any reallocation of funds within the proviso.  No fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 1015</b> Washington State Green Bank	Provides that the legislative members serving on the Green Bank board of directors are non-voting and may not be compensated for their service on the board of directors.  No fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 1022</b> Skokomish Timber Land Acquisition	Moves the \$2,000,000 appropriation for the Skokomish Timber Land Acquisition project from the Department of Commerce to <b>Sec. 3013</b> under the Recreation and Conservation Office.  No net fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 1023</b> Local Climate Resiliency	Adds \$4,137,000 from the Climate Commitment Account the Hoh Highlands Resiliency and Governance Center Project. This funding is appropriated but unallocated within the Local Climate Resiliency appropriation under H-3630.2.  No net fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 1025</b> Affordable Housing Supply and Preservation	Adds \$366,000 in bonds for the Howerton Place (Kingston) project.  Bonds: \$366,000
<b>Commerce – Section 1028</b> Disaster Response and Resiliency Infrastructure	Sets aside \$1,000,000 of the \$9,000,000 appropriation for the permitting and construction costs related to the Whatcom county Fire Protection District #1 Emergency Station Relocation project. Specifies that permissible uses of remaining grant funds provided under this section include repair, rehabilitation, and construction of flood mitigation and disaster response and resiliency projects.  No net fiscal change.
<b>DCYF – Section 2016</b> Additional Juvenile Rehabilitation Capacity	Restores funding for design and requires the department to develop a plan for a secure facility on the east side of the Cascade Mountains. Requires the department to consult with relevant entities to ensure that proposed occupancy use and site modifications are permissible. Requires the department's decision package for the 2027-29 biennial capital budget to include a transition timeline from Harbor Heights, a strategy to close Harbor Heights after relocation, and an update on the east Cascade facility development.  Bonds: -\$500,000

<b>Ecology – Section 3002</b> Waste Tire Pile Cleanup and Prevention	Allocates \$200,000 from the Waste Tire Removal Account to the Twin Bridges Road Tire Pile Clean-up project and adds \$3,000,000 to the same project for a total of \$3,200,000.  Waste Tire Removal Account: \$3,000,000
<b>OSPI – Section 5007</b> School Electrification	Adds the Office of Financial Management as a recipient of a report required of the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction.  No fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 7003</b> 2022 Local & Community Projects	Changes the name of the Renton Housing Repair Assistance Program (Renton) project to the Renton Resource Center project.  No fiscal change.
<b>Commerce – Section 7007</b> 2024 Local and Community Projects	Changes the name of the SPARC Capital Campaign (Mount Vernon) project to "SPARC Capital Grant - Revised."  No fiscal change.
<b>Section 8012 [Added Amendatory Section]</b>	Specifies that the legislative intent regarding conditions for future reappropriations applies to grant programs and community projects appropriated from the state building construction account.  No fiscal change.
<b>DOH – Section 8013 (New Section)</b>	Requires the Department of Health to name the South Laboratory Addition the "Mary C. Selecky Environmental Laboratories" in honor of the former Washington State Secretary of Health Mary Selecky.  No fiscal change.
<b>Other Technical Changes</b>	Removes superfluous sections and repeals a reappropriation for which there is no remaining funding. Corrects a typographical error.  No fiscal change.
