Introduction

The enacted 2017-19 capital budget (SSB 6090; Laws of 2018, Chapter 2) appropriated \$2,719 million from state bond proceeds from the net bond authorization (E2SHB 1080; Laws of 2018, Chapter 3) of \$2,930 million; the remaining bond capacity was \$211 million.

PSSB 6095 is the 2018 supplemental capital budget; this proposal makes new bond appropriations of \$186.3 million and \$148.5 million in cash accounts for a total appropriation of \$334.7 million. The bond capacity remaining for the 2019 supplemental capital budget is \$24.9 million. Reappropriation savings are \$94,000 in state bonds and \$50 million in other funds.

The following summarizes major bond investments in PSSB 6095.

Public Schools

Bond funding in the enacted biennial budget totaled \$760 million. The supplemental budget makes the following increases totaling \$66.2 million:

- School Construction Assistance Program: \$51.3 million
- Distressed Schools: \$9 million
- Small Rural District Modernization Grants: \$6.0 million

<u>Higher Education</u>

Funding is provided for designs of major projects at the State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC), including:

- Cascadia Center for Science and Technology: \$3.4 million
- Everett Community College: Learning and Resource Center: \$4.0 million
- Grays Harbor College: Student Services and Instructional Building: \$4.2 million
- North Seattle Library building Renovation: \$3.5 million
- Walla Walla Science and Technology Building Replacement: \$1.2 million

Savings totaling \$17.5 million are taken for Facility Repairs, Minor Works and Site Repairs.

In addition, the budget authorizes \$112 million in alternative financed projects at the SBCTC. Please see the list of alternative financed projects elsewhere in this document.

Behavioral Health

The supplemental budget makes additional investments in state mental hospitals and community-based facilities, including:

- \$27 million for two additional forensic wards at Western State Hospital
- Behavioral Health Community Capacity competitive grants are increased by \$33 million
- \$2 million is provided for Behavioral Rehabilitation Services Capacity Grants

Local and Community Projects

\$24.5 million is provided to the Department of Commerce to make grants to local governments and nonprofit organizations statewide for wide range of 55 community-based projects.

Natural Resources

\$7 million is provided for the Healthy Housing Remediation Program, including \$5 million for Mount Baker Properties Cleanup and Affordable Housing Development

State Parks projects are funded at \$3.6 million above the 2017-19 enacted capital budget

\$11.7 million is provided for Aquatic Land Enhancement Account projects; 22 additional projects will be funded.
